Season of Glorious Resurrection
Jesus' New Commandment
June 02, 2019



Jesus was aware that His work on earth was rapidly coming to an end. He was conscious of His suffering, death and resurrection and His departure to His Father in heaven. So He wanted to teach His disciples—and His Church down the ages—a lesson in Christian love: “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another as I have loved you.”

In Christ’s new command, the significant words are “as I have loved you.” Christ’s command to love “as I have loved you” is the “new commandment.” The love that Christ had and continues to have for His followers is infinitely more profound than the love expressed in “you shall love your neighbor as yourself.” When Christians express love toward others, it should not be just as we love ourselves, but as Christ loves us.

That is the kind of love that Christ has for His Church and the love He expects Christians to have. Without that love, we would have no hope and no opportunity to live forever.
