Season of Glorious Epiphany Epiphany: Baptism of the Lord January 06, 2019



After celebrating Christmas, the incarnation of the Son of God, the Gospel takes us immediately into the celebration of His Baptism when Jesus was 30 years old. He stepped into the Jordan River and was baptized by Saint John the Baptist, who felt he was not even worthy to unstrap the sandals from Christ's feet.

Though Christ was born free of original sin, He submitted to baptism and instituted the Sacrament of baptism. With the voice of God from above, and the Spirit descending upon Him... Christ's flesh actually blessed the waters...and made them Holy... conferring the power of baptism.

Christ's baptism is called "Epiphany" for it revealed to mankind His divinity. It was a moment of divine manifestation and also reveals the mystery of God's plan of salvation.

The sacrament of baptism is necessary for our salvation. We need it to become the adopted sons and daughters of God. It frees us from original sin and incorporates us into God's family.

From the Letter of Saint Paul to his disciple Titus 2:11-3:7

Brothers and Sisters, The grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all, training us to reject godless ways and worldly desires and to live lives that are just, self-controlled, and devout, as we await the blessed hope - the appearance of the glory of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He gave himself for us that He might redeem us from all iniquity and purify for Himself - a people of His own who are eager to do what is right and good.

For when the goodness and loving kindness of God Our Savior appeared, He saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but according to His mercy through the water of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit. This Spirit He poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ, Our Savior, so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

From the Gospel of our Lord according to Luke 3:15-22

As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John as to whether he might be the Messiah, John answered all of them by saying, "I baptize you with water; but One who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of His sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in His hand, to clear His threshing floor and to gather the wheat into His granary; but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire." Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with You I am well pleased."
