# Entrance into Great Lent Cana Sunday

March 03, 2019



Everyone knows the story of the first of the Lord's "signs" — how Jesus changed water into wine at the wedding feast of Cana at the request of Mary, His mother. But there is more to the story than at first meets the eye.

The wedding feast of Cana reveals the divine power at work in this carpenter from Nazareth. And it does this in the middle of everyday life - at a wedding reception.

The Gospel of John calls the Lord's miracles "signs." They all point to Jesus' divinity. But they also profoundly symbolize what it is that He has come into this world to do for us.

At Cana He transforms water into wine. How does Jesus work this transformation? Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the same power that transformed chaos into paradise, a virgin into the mother of God, bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ and sinners into the children of God.

Mary's Mission was about self-giving and loving service, such as asking her son to do something at the wedding at Cana. There Jesus, at the request of his mother, carries out His first miracle. Mary's intercession could be - a motivation, an incentive - a catalyst for the first miracle. It could be the catalyst for many more.

#### From the Letter of Saint Paul to Romans 14:14-23

The kingdom of God is not a matter of food and drink, but of righteousness, peace, and joy in the holy Spirit; whoever serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and approved by others. Let us then pursue what leads to peace and to building up one another. For the sake of food, do not destroy the work of God. Everything is indeed clean, but it is wrong for anyone to become a stumbling block by eating; it is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to stumble. Keep the faith that you have to yourself in the presence of God; blessed is the one who does not condemn himself for what he approves. But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because this is not from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.

## The Gospel of John 2:1-11 (The miracle at the wedding in Cana of Galilee)

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." (And) Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from (although the servers who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now."
