Please allow at least <u>Six months</u> of preparation time. Date arrangements are made after the initial meet with pastor before any other commitments are made.


Ministry of the Sick

Feast of Our Lady of Lebanon May 28, 2017



Since 1908, the Churches of Lebanon officially started commemorating the Lady of Lebanon's day in a solemn ceremony the first Sunday of May. On that day, the statue of the Virgin Mary was erected on top of a new sanctuary over the hill of Harissa.

When the Shrine was inaugurated in 1908, the Patriarch Elias Hoyek dedicated Lebanon to the Virgin Mary: "Oh Mary, Queen of mountains and seas and Queen of our beloved Lebanon..."




