Please allow at least <u>Six months</u> of preparation time. Date arrangements are made after the initial meet with pastor before any other commitments are made.


Ministry of the Sick

From the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans 8:1-11


Brothers and Sisters, now there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the spirit of life in Christ Jesus has freed you from sin and death. For those who live according to the flesh are concerned with the things of the flesh, and those who live according to the spirit are concerned with the things of the spirit. The concern of the flesh is death, but the concern of the spirit is life and peace. The concern of the flesh is hostility toward God; it does not submit to the law of God, nor can it; and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

But you are not in the flesh; on the contrary, you are in the spirit, if only the Spirit of God dwells in you. Whoever does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if the Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he will give life to your mortal bodies. **Praise be to God Always!**

The Festival is a major parish fundraiser. Such an event would not be possible without the generous support of volunteers, businesses, and community organizations.






