

42 but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."



Dear Parents,

I would like to welcome you all back to our MRE program and want you to know what a great blessing it is for us to serve you. It has been a challenging time for all of us, but with God's Grace we plan to meet in person again while monitoring the situation and taking it one step at a time.

A few guidelines to share with you:

- Registration begins: Sunday, August 22nd (Pre-K to high school). Deadline: September 19.
- In person classes start: September 19 from 10:25am 11:25am. (Online classes are an option **only** if necessary.)
- If your child was not baptized at Our Lady of Lebanon, please provide a copy of the Baptismal Certificate.
- Classes will be ready according to the CDC and the Diocese of Joliet Guidelines. Wipes and sanitizers will be supplied in each classroom.
- At this time, face masks are mandatory for students and teachers.
- Meeting with parents is scheduled for October 3rd, to go over in detail the program's requirements and expectations.




2021 Senior Fair October 6th - "Services for Seniors"


