
Dear Parents,

I would like to welcome you all back to our MRE program and want you to know what a great blessing it is for us to serve you. It has been a challenging time for all of us, but with God's Grace we plan to meet in person again while monitoring the situation and taking it one step at a time.

A few guidelines to share with you:

- Registration begins: Sunday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> (Pre-K to high school).  
Deadline: September 19.
- In person classes start: September 19 from 10:25am - 11:25am.  
(Online classes are an option **only** if necessary.)
- If your child was not baptized at Our Lady of Lebanon, please provide a copy of the Baptismal Certificate.
- Classes will be ready according to the CDC and the Diocese of Joliet Guidelines. Wipes and sanitizers will be supplied in each classroom.
- **At this time**, face masks are mandatory for students and teachers.
- Meeting with parents is scheduled for October 3<sup>rd</sup>, to go over in detail the program's requirements and expectations.

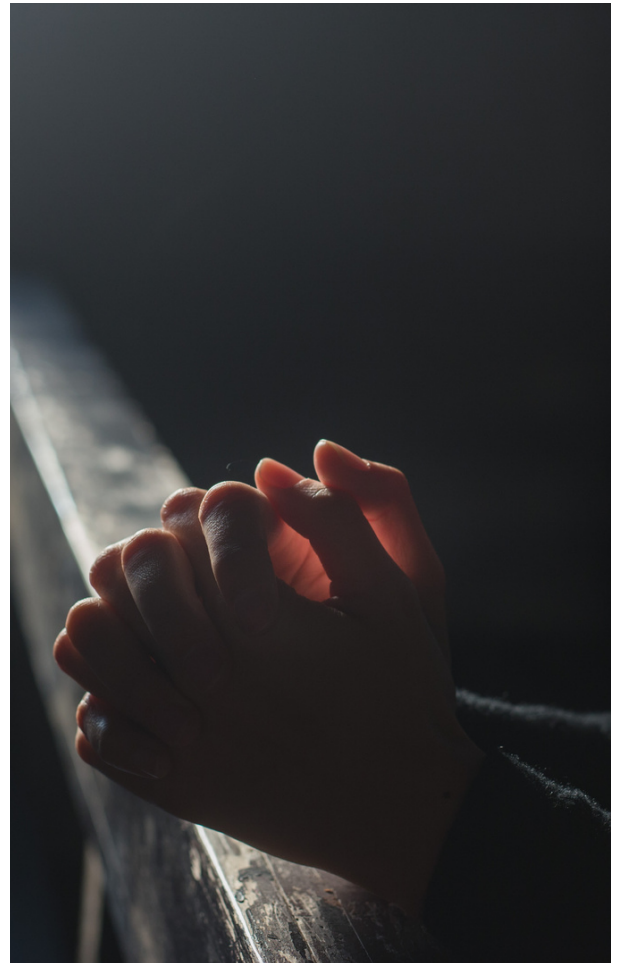

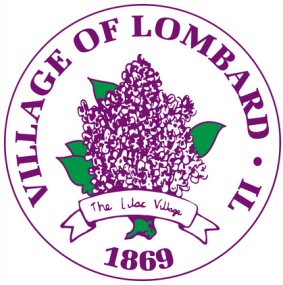
Let us pray for the Church, that she may receive from the Holy Spirit the grace and strength to reform herself in the light of the Gospel.
