Jesus Calling the 12 Apostles

Luke 11:1-4, 9-13

1 His disciples said to him, “Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.”

2 He said to them, “When you pray, say: “Father hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. **3** Give us each day our daily bread. **4** Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation.”

ILLINOIS PHASE 5: COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The state of Illinois is expected to enter Phase 5 on Friday, June 11. Our Lady of Lebanon will follow Illinois public health guidelines and offers the following details for all church services effective June 11, assuming the state does enter Phase 5:

- Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks and they can participate in indoor\outdoor activities. Individuals who have not been vaccinated should continue to wear masks.
- Hand sanitization is recommended.
- Dispensation to attend Sunday Mass remains in place for the time being.
- Full capacity is allowed, and registration is no longer required.
- During communion, there will be 2 lines with the option to receive the sacrament either in the hand or on the tongue.
- We will provide a seating area for parishioners uneasy with sitting with unmasked individuals.
- Starting Sunday, June 13, livestreaming is no longer available.

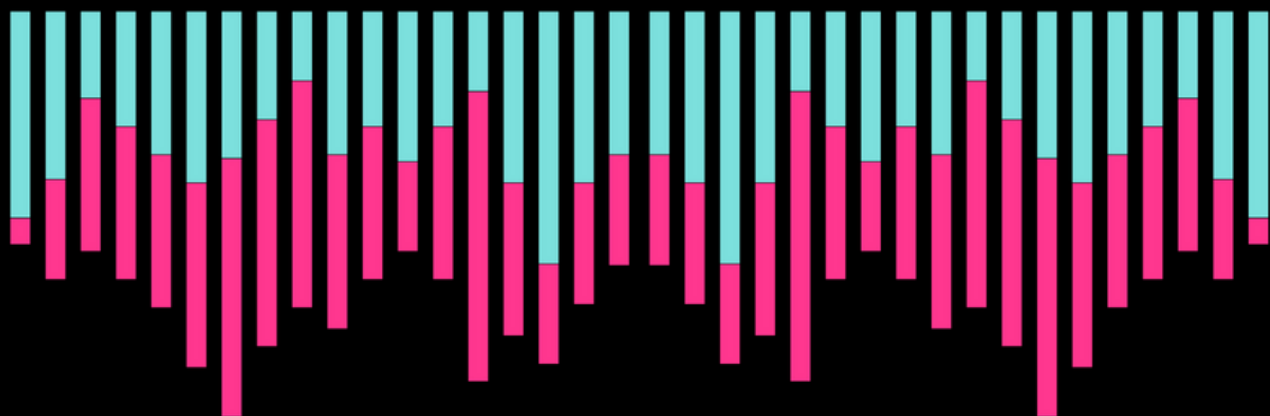

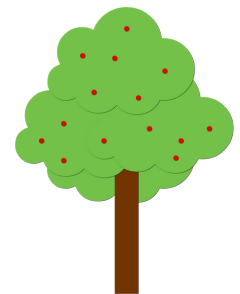

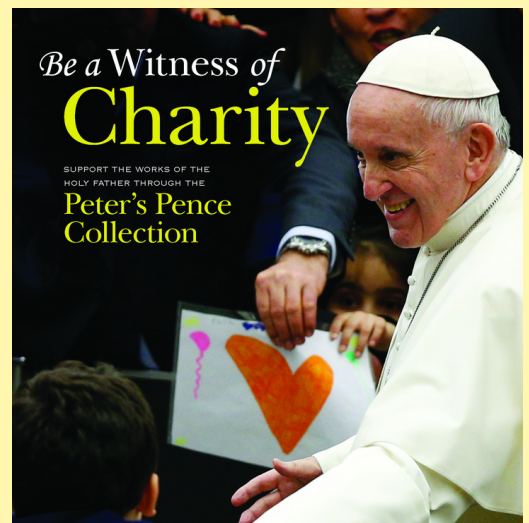
1 Dear Lord, please remember our children as they finish this school year. May their heart rejoice in much needed rest and be ready for the next step in their journey. We pray to you O Lord.
