# IMPORTANT

## >>> ANNOUNCEMENT <<<

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) announced new provisions of temporary immigration reprieve for Lebanese Nationals who are part of the Deferred Enforced Departure (DED) and the new Temporary Protected Status (TPS) designations due to the ongoing conflict in the region.

The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services has established procedures for Lebanese nationals who are covered under the Deferred Enforced Departure grant by President Biden from July 26, 2024. They may apply for Employment Authorization Documents that will be valid until January 25, 2026.

Lebanese nationals in the U.S. may be able to apply for TPS designations for 18 months due to the ongoing conflict and conditions in Lebanon. Also, DHS will be releasing new guidelines for F-1 nonimmigrant students with Lebanese citizenship. These students may request employment authorization, increase the work hours they have while in school, and reduce their courses through the new designation period. Individuals must meet all standards and eligibility criteria. Determination will be on a case-by-case basis.

Please check with an immigration lawyer to see if you are eligible for these programs and the provisions DHS has made for Lebanese nationals in the U.S.
