Please allow at least <u>six months</u> of preparation time. Date arrangements are made after the initial meet with pastor before any other commitments are made.


Ministry of the Sick

Jesus opened His home to friends and strangers. The effect was twofold. **First,** Jesus welcomed all, regardless of social status or immoral past. **Second,** the "open house" atmosphere allowed the enemies of Jesus on His own turf. Jesus and His followers would suffer for their openness. Nonetheless, suffering was necessary to proclaim the Kingdom.

"They removed the roof above Him"

This scripture has to make you wonder "How much faith do I really have?" Our faith isn't tested when we are at peace and everything is so wonderful. Our faith is tested when our very breath is being taken from us. We are tested when we are down and usually at our worst. That is when we must turn to Jesus, but that can't be the only time we turn to Him.

Restoration

Forgiveness is meant to be a restoration. (His place in the community). More important, Jesus call the men "Child," He gave the man a place in God's Kingdom.

"Rise" = a reference to resurrection. Pick up your mat = a sign of power over his helplessness. Go to your house = a reference to family, his place in community.

For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One, your Savior; you are precious and honored in my sight, and I love you. Do not be afraid, for I am with you.

From the First Letter of Saint Paul to Timothy 6:6-19

Faith with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. Those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called by God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is Holy and immortal, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honor and might forever.

From the Gospel of our Lord according to Mark 2:1-12

When Jesus returned to Capernaum after some days, it became known that he was at home. Many gathered together so that there was no longer room for them, not even around the door, and he preached the word to them. They came bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men. Unable to get near Jesus because of the crowd, they opened up the roof above him. After they had broken through, they let down the mat on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Child, your sins are forgiven."

Now some of the scribes were sitting there asking themselves, "Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming. Who but God alone can forgive sins?" Jesus immediately knew in his mind what they were thinking to themselves, so he said, "Why are you thinking such things in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, pick up your mat and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority to forgive sins on earth"-- he said to the paralytic, "I say to you, rise, pick up your mat, and go home." He rose, picked up his mat at once, and went away in the sight of everyone.
