## Glorious Epiphany Revelation of Christ to John the Baptist JANUARY 12, 2019

#### A reading from The Acts of the Apostles 19:1-6

They replied, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." He said, "How were you baptized?" They replied, "With the baptism of John." He said, John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus." On hearing this, they asked to be baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they were filled with power.

#### From the Gospel of our Lord according to John 1:29-34

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him and declared, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me.' I myself did not know him; but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel." And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God."
