Peter is Chosen to Guide the Flock John 21:15-19

15 When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?"

"Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Feed my lambs."

16 Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love me?"

He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you."


Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep." 17 The third time he said to him.


"Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Feed my sheep.

18 Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go."

19 Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, "Follow me!"

Peter, do you love me? Tend my sheep.

The Maronite church meditates on this fifth Sunday of the Resurrection Season on Jesus calling Peter to tend his sheep.

Jesus called Peter for a double mission: a fisher of men and a shepherd: "by hook and by crook." I think this "by hook and by crook" is an exciting theme.

The hook is what the fishermen use to catch fish. The crook is the shepherd's staff that he uses to gather the sheep of the flock.

Every Christian is called to be a fisher of others, to find the right "hooks" to bring people to the fold.

I also think that every Christian is called to have a "crook," a way of touching the lives of others that demonstrates God's great love and care.

The whole mission that Jesus is calling us to is reaching the human heart and that's why Jesus says to his disciples, especially Peter: Follow me.





The father suffers from diabetes, blood pressure and heart problems, & had several back surgeries. Requires permanent medication for his health problems.


Father's health issues prevented him from working. His sister was let go from work, 6 months ago. Their financial condition is bad.




