St. Anthony of Padua

June 13

*Invoked for finding lost objects,
known as the "Hammer of Heretics"
and a worker of miracles*

He was born as Ferdinand in Lisbon, Portugal during 1195, the son of an army officer named Martin and a virtuous woman named Mary.

He entered the Augustinian order at age 15. In 1220, Ferdinand learned the news about five Franciscan friars who had recently died for their faith in Morocco.

He developed a passionate desire to imitate their commitment to the Gospel. He decided to follow Christ in the Franciscan poor and humble way of life.

His eloquence stunned the crowd, and St. Francis himself soon learned what kind of man the dishwashing priest really was. In 1224 he gave Anthony permission to teach theology in the order.

Anthony taught theology in several French and Italian cities, while strictly following his Franciscan vows and preaching regularly to the people who had fallen away from Catholic faith and morality.

St. Anthony's well-established holiness, combined with the many miracles he had worked during his lifetime, moved Pope Gregory IX – who knew the saint personally – to canonize him one year after his death.

ILLINOIS PHASE 5: COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The state of Illinois is expected to enter Phase 5 on Friday, June 11. Our Lady of Lebanon will follow Illinois public health guidelines and offers the following details for all church services effective June 11, assuming the state does enter Phase 5:

- Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks and they can participate in indoor\outdoor activities. Individuals who have not been vaccinated should continue to wear masks.
- Hand sanitization is recommended.
- Dispensation to attend Sunday Mass remains in place for the time being.
- Full capacity is allowed, and registration is no longer required.
- During communion, there will be 2 lines with the option to receive the sacrament either in the hand or on the tongue.
- We will provide a seating area for parishioners uneasy with sitting with unmasked individuals.
- Starting Sunday, June 13, livestreaming is no longer available.

I pray with you for all who work hard to battle with this pandemic; I pray for the people who lost a loved one, and for the sick. May God bless us and give us blessed days full of health and faith.

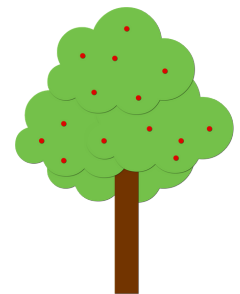

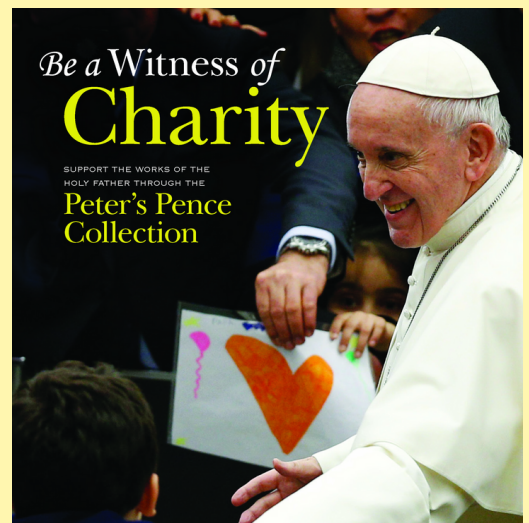
1 Dear Lord, please remember our children as they finish this school year. May their heart rejoice in much needed rest and be ready for the next step in their journey. We pray to you O Lord.
