Repentance of Zacchaeus the Tax Collector



Salvation of Zacchaeus Luke 19: 1-10

- 1 Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through.
- **2** A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy.
- **3** He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd
- **4** So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.
- **5** When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today."

- **6** So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.
- **7** All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."
- 8 But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."
- **9** Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham.
- **10** For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."




Thanksgiving Prayer




Pope Francis Intentions


